Music, Ethics, Community Service - *MSLMYSO* empowers its musicians to go forward as upstanding citizens. Many of the *MSLMYSO* alumni have earned attendance to and received major scholarship awards from the nation's most prestigious universities.

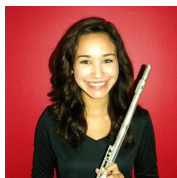

Luke Collins, son of Mitchell and Sylvia Collins, began playing music in the third grade with the Youth Center After School Music Program. He quickly took to the violin and by the 5th grade had earned himself a seat in MSLMYSO and their Australian concert tour. The success of this tour motivated Luke to push his musical boundaries. He continued his role in MSLM throughout middle and high school as a violinist but also took to the contra bass in school orchestra as well as contemporary and worship music in his church and as a singer songwriter. It was not until earlier this year that Luke found his musical niche in viola. Luke takes private lessons from Marcy Sudock. In just a few short months, he has excelled on the instrument and earned a spot in the music program with a full tuition scholarship to Pepperdine University.



Kealani Jensen is seventeen years old and in her senior year of high school at Hope Christian Academy. Her parents are Jeffery and Beverly Jensen and she has been playing flute for ten years. She joined Musique Sur La Mer in eighth grade and went on tour with the orchestra to Australia and New Zealand in 2009. Kealani has taken private lessons with Renee Grizzell for seven years. She will be attending California Polytechnic University: San Luis Obispo in the Fall to study architecture and she hopes to continue her music by joining the symphony orchestra. This is Kealani's second time winning the solo competition. Kealani is excited about her schooling and can't wait to see what the future holds.

Marcy A. Sudock - Founding Director - Conductor

Marcy A. Sudock is the founding musical director and conductor of Musique Sur La Mer Orchestras, including the Musique Sur La Mer Orchestra, Chamber Ensembles, Youth Symphony Orchestra and Honors Chamber Orchestra and The Youth Center Music Director for the After School Music Program. Marcy Sudock graduated with her degree in Music Performance, from California State University, Long Beach. She is a professional performing violinist, soloist, chamber musician, studio and orchestral musician, conductor and arranger. She studied the violin with Vera Barstow, Manuel Compinsky, Robert Sanov, Ken Goldsmith and Pavol Farkas. She has performed with Luciano Pavarotti, Andrea Bocelli, Lionel Richie, Lou Rawls, Marni Nixon, Steve Mercurio, Leonard Penario and Freddie Hubbard, to name a few. Marcy Sudock, has conducted concerts to sold out audiences in Austria: Musikverien-Saal (Vienna), the Mozarteum in Salzburg, the Salzburg Cathedral, University Festival Hall and Mirabel Gardens, the Czech Republic, France, Monaco, Costa Rica's Teatro Nacional, New Zealand and Australia's Sydney Opera House. In 2011, Maestro Sudock conducted the professional orchestra, Musique Sur La Mer, performing before a sold out audience at the Royal College of Music in London, England on the occasion of the wedding of HRH Prince William to Catherine Middleton, the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge. This June, Marcy will be returning to London to conduct a concert in honor of the Diamond Jubilee of HRM Queen Elizabeth II. Maestro Sudock's passion and exuberance for life is reflected in her family, her community involvements, her teaching and her music.

SPECIAL GUEST STARS



Tony McEwing, Fox11 News Anchorman - Master of Ceremonies. Since 1993 Tony McEwing has been a familiar face on LA television screens. For the past twenty years, Tony has co-anchored the FOX 11 Morning News with Jean Martirez. He frequently steps in as host for the Emmy winning Good Day LA. In 2001 & 2003, McEwing was honored with Emmy Awards for his half hour specials "Songs of Our Success." In 1997, McEwing filed a three-part report on the Los Angeles Mission's yearlong rehabilitation program that earned a nomination for a Los Angeles area Emmy award. The reports were later compiled into the half-hour news special, Mission of Hope, which won the national Iris Award in the Best Current Affairs category, won a Golden Mike Award for Best Documentary and earned a National Emmy nomination in 1998. McEwing anchored three hours of continuous live coverage of the North Hollywood Bank Shootout and filed live reports from Chicago during the 1996 Democratic National Convention. He participated in the coverage of the 1994 Rose Parade, interviewing participants during the live pre-parade special. In 1994, he anchored KTTV's Crown Books teacher salute, profiling

outstanding Southland educators. The Chicago native is active in the community, speaking at numerous community functions as well as helping youth through mentoring programs. Before KTTV, McEwing spent 12 years working at KXTV, then the CBS affiliate in Sacramento, where he anchored the morning and noon newscasts. While at the station, he filed in-depth reports on the Southland, including the Rodney King trial and the civil unrest. Prior to KXTV, McEwing was the Washington, D.C. correspondent for WDSU, the NBC affiliate in New Orleans, Louisiana from 1980-81. His reporting career includes a stint as a reporter for The News Sun, the largest daily newspaper in suburban (Chicago) Lake County, where he covered the business and industry beat during the summer of 1980. McEwing earned a Masters degree in editorial broadcasting from the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University in 1981, where he received a Bachelor of Science in education in 1978 and attended the School of Law. A longtime supporter of Musique Sur la Mer, this evening marks Tony's fifth turn as Gala benefit Master of Ceremonies.



Rubén Sanchez ~ Bass/baritone. was born in Brooklyn, New York and grew up in Old Bridge, NJ. He studied voice at Rutgers College in New Brunswick, NJ, with Frederick Urrey/Tenor and double majored earning a Bachelor of Arts degree in Music and Psychology. Mr. Sanchez moved to Long Beach, California at the end of 1987. He has sung with the Long Beach Opera Company, the Bach Camerata Singers of Long Beach, El Coro de Los Angeles. He has also served as Cantor at St. Matthew Catholic Church in Long Beach, and presently at Holy Trinity Catholic Church in San Pedro.



Crystal Sepulveda, soprano, is a graduate from California State University, Long Beach where she had received her Bachelor of Music in Vocal Performance under the study of Shigemi Matsumoto. She received scholarships for her studies and performed with the CSULB University Choir, and the CSULB Collegium Musicum. Before attending CSULB, Ms. Sepulveda studied voice at El Camino College. She received two faculty scholarships from the music department and a scholarship from Los Concioneros Community Choir with whom she has performed as a featured soloist. Ms. Sepulveda was the music director for Holy Trinity Catholic Church's Life Teen Band and currently cantors for the church today. She has also been contributing her time in the production of San Pedro High School's musical theater production of *Bye Bye Birdie* as a vocal coach.
